Dear Friend,

Thank you for your interest in commencing a course of study with Tyndale College, the Australasian Open Theological College. In our Prospectus you will find full information about the College and its Course. Please note that the College does not hold classroom lectures: we provide our Lectures on audio tape or MP3 CD-ROM, for you to study at the time and place of your own choosing. And we supply a Study Calendar and Guide, and we link you with one of our Tutors.

The Prospectus shows you the details of the full College Course, in which you are able progressively to qualify for the awards of the three Course Levels: Associate Certificate in Theology (A.C.Th.), Licentiate in Theology (L.Th.), and Scholar in Theology (Th.Schol.). Each Level requires the completion (over whatever period of time suits your individual circumstances) of eight Subject Units of study (the equivalent of a year of fulltime work), plus participation in a three-day Annual Conference at the College at Hunters Hill, Sydney. You are able to exit the Course after Levels One or Two, or to proceed to complete the full Course.

However, although the award made in recognition of your work is important, more important by far is the work itself that you are doing and the knowledge you are gaining. As you will read on page 3, the College has “the primary purpose of providing a comprehensive training in Christian teaching for lay persons, that will assist them with, and make them more effective in, their roles within their churches as elders, deacons, churchwardens, parish council members, Sunday School teachers, youth leaders, leaders of Bible Study groups, Christian school teachers; and those in leadership roles in parachurch organizations: indeed, workers of every kind in every sort of Christian association.” If you seek this training, the College is here to provide it for you.

Included is an Enrolment Form. Note the information about the Preliminary Unit, 001. You can apply now to enrol in the College, to commence your studies next Semester. Details of how to apply for enrolment in the College are set out on this site, plus the schedule of College fees..

Unless you are granted exemption on the basis of equivalent work done (or of having already acquired these study skills plus an overall knowledge of the Bible), and have paid the exemption fee, your first subject is the Preliminary Unit 001: *Effective Writing and Study*. If you have the time available, you may wish to apply to study your first Course Unit at the same time as *Effective Writing and Study*. If you apply to do this, or if you are exempted from all or Part A of *Effective Writing and Study*, then your Course itself commences with Unit 111: *Introduction to the Old Testament*. But be aware: the Course you are undertaking is at university level, and requires work!

To enrol: please now fill in the included Enrolment Form, and send it back to the office as soon as possible, together with the documents which are requested. You can then be enrolled for the next Semester.
